

CORPORATE CONTRIBUTIONS

1. Purpose:

1.1 Corporate Contributions shall:

- 1.1.1. Provide for beneficial working partnerships between the International Association of Women Police (IAWP) and other organizations and businesses;
- 1.1.2. Contribute financial and in-kind contributions towards IAWP recognitions, scholarships, awards events and other projects;
- 1.1.3. Provide corporate contributors access to a range of benefits based on the level of contribution and subject to negotiation and agreement between the contributor and IAWP..

2. Objective:

Corporate contributors shall have the specific rights and privileges determined by this policy and the Board of Directors.

3. Procedure

3.1 Benefits may include but are not limited to:

3.1.1. Recognizing that businesses and other organizations have varying goals when making corporate contributions, benefits provided are flexible and may be customized to suit the needs of the contributor.

3.1.2. Benefits may include:

- 3.2.1.1. Advertisement in *Women Police* magazine;
- 3.2.1.2. Exhibit booth at the annual training conference;
- 3.2.1.3. Recognition on the IAWP website;
- 3.2.1.4. Tickets to special events such as the IAWP Annual Recognition Program Ceremony;
- 3.2.1.5. Other benefits mutually agreed upon by the contributor and the IAWP.

3.2. Conflicts of Interest:

3.2.1. Corporate contributions shall not be accepted from any organization whose goals and business practices reflect negatively on the IAWP, women or law enforcement/criminal justice. If there is any question, final approval shall be voted on by the IAWP Board of Directors.

3.2.2. When a benefit provided to a corporate contributor involves an expense to the annual training conference (e.g. exhibit booth, conference registrations, luncheon/banquet tickets, etc.) that expense shall be paid by the IAWP to the conference committee.

This policy shall in no way interfere with the contribution or sponsorship policies set by the CONFERENCE COMMITTEE. It is the responsibility and prerogative of each CONFERENCE COMMITTEE to establish its own contribution or sponsorship plan.
